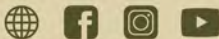

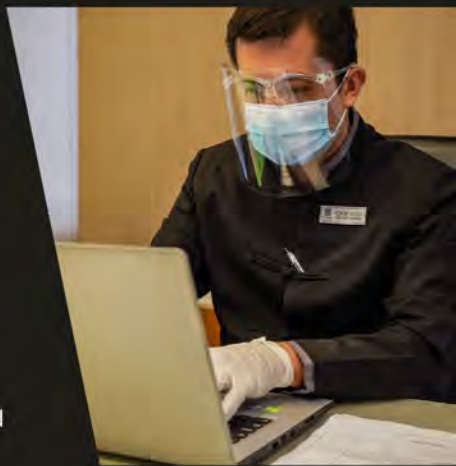

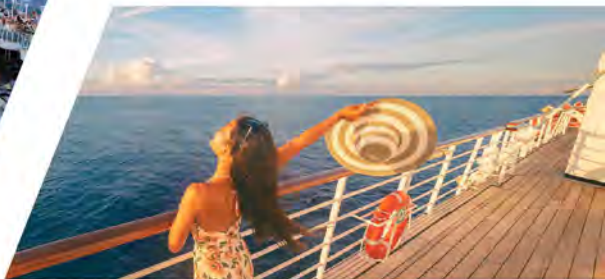

# THE CRUISE SHIP INDUSTRY

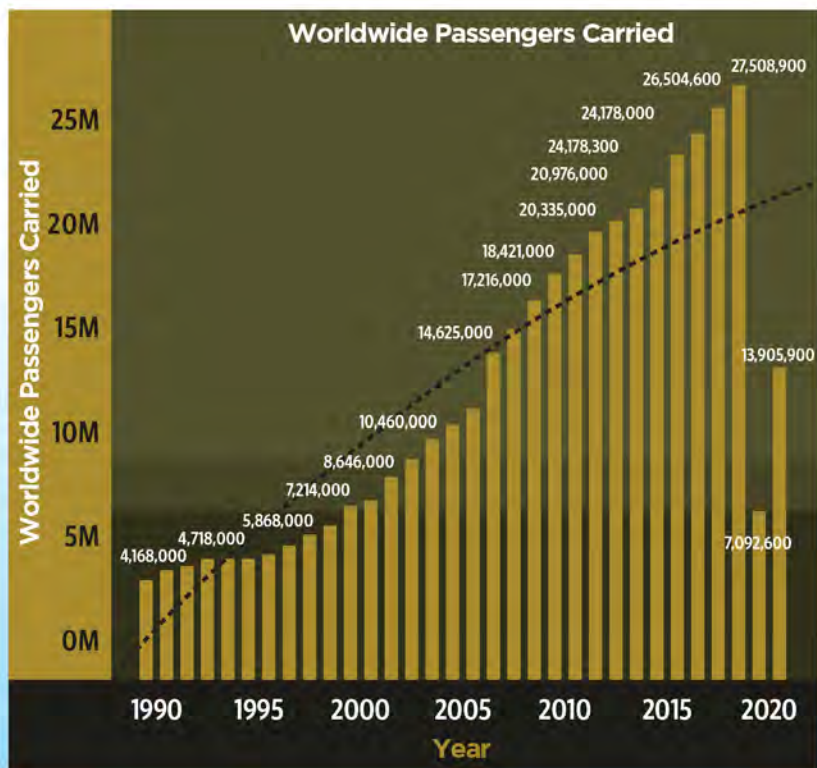
